



ORDINANCE NO. 26-0915-F3

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF ENNIS, TEXAS, AMENDING SECTION 2-1 "MUNICIPAL FEE AND USE SCHEDULE" IN ARTICLE I "IN GENERAL" OF CHAPTER 2 "ADMINISTRATION" OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES BY CODIFYING AND ADOPTING A REVISED COMPREHENSIVE SCHEDULE OF FEES TO BE CHARGED FOR MUNICIPAL SERVICES; PROVIDING THE EFFECTIVE DATES.

WHEREAS, the City Commission adopted by Ordinance a Schedule of Fees; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission desires to make revisions to the Schedule of Fees for Fiscal Year 2027, with an effective date of October 1, 2026;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF ENNIS, TX:

SECTION 1: That Section 2-1 "Municipal Fee and Use Schedule" in Article I "In General" of Chapter 2 "Administration" of the Code of Ordinances shall be amended to reflect the changes shown in the fee schedule as **Exhibit A**.

SECTION 2: Severability. It is hereby declared to be the intention of the City Commission of the City of Ennis that the phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs, and sections of this Ordinance are severable, and if any phrase, clause, sentence paragraph, or section of this Ordinance shall be declared unconstitutional by the valid judgment or decree of any court of competent jurisdiction, such unconstitutionality shall not affect any of the remaining phrases, clauses, sentences paragraphs, and sections of this Ordinance, since the same would have been enacted by the City Commission without the incorporation of this Ordinance if any such unconstitutional phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, or section.

SECTION 3: Savings/Repealing Clause. This Ordinance shall be cumulative of all other Ordinances and shall not repeal any of the provisions of such Ordinances except for those instances where there are direct conflicts with the provisions of this Ordinance. Ordinances, or parts thereof, in force at the time this Ordinance shall take effect and that are inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent that they are inconsistent with this Ordinance. Provided however, that any complaint, action, claim or lawsuit which has been initiated or has arisen under or pursuant to such other Ordinances on this date of adoption of this Ordinance shall continue to be governed by the provisions of such Ordinance and for that purpose the Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.
