## Free Landfill Disposal Days City of Ennis Residents

#### What do I need to bring?

A current City of Ennis water bill and a valid driver's license with matching name and address.

A hard hat and safety vest are required for anyone unloading in the active dumping zone. Hard hats and safety vests are available for purchase at the scale house if you do not have them.

- \$12.00 Hard hat & disposable safety vest
- \$12.00 Hard hat
- \$12.00 Reusable safety vest

#### When can I go?

The first and third Saturday from 7:00 am to 11:00 am.

### Are there any limits?

Each household can dispose up to 2 cubic yards. Equivalent to the size of 2 washing machines.

Accepted items include:

- Household items
- Branches or limbs

Prohibited items include:

- Appliances containing freon such as refrigerators and air conditioners
- Containers holding liquid
- Hazardous materials such as pesticides, car batteries, motor oil, or medical waste

Note: Tires are accepted for an additional fee.
