Job Summary

This position will perform maintenance duties found in the Utility Department, which include water and sewer. Perform installation, repair, or maintenance duties in support of Utility department. Repair and/or maintain related equipment. Other duties as assigned may include street maintenance, storm water, street sweeping, solid waste, park grounds, street signage, building/facilities, and related activities.

Essential Job Functions

- Safely operate a variety of power and hand tools, trucks, and light machinery.
- Perform problem analysis, perform basic math, creatively solve work problems, and provide a high level of customer service.
- Speak, read, write, and understand English.
- Make decisions based on sound judgment leading to logical conclusions.
- Mental activities requiring using independent judgment, decision making, applying interpersonal and customer service skills, and participating in a team environment.
- Physical activities require complete motions of the body to complete public works maintenance and repair work.
