Job Summary: This position will perform maintenance duties found in the Utility Department, which include water and sewer. Perform installation, repair, or maintenance duties in support of Utility department. Repair and/or maintain related equipment. Other duties as assigned may include street maintenance, storm water, street sweeping, solid waste, park grounds, street signage, building/facilities, and related activities.

Minimum Qualifications:

- Texas State Driver's License.
- Valid Texas State Class B Commercial Driver's License (within 6 months of employment).
- High school diploma or equivalent is required.
- Position requires certifications: Water Distribution Class C, and Wastewater Collection II within 24 months (2 years) of hire.

Essential Job Functions and Duties:

- Safely operate a variety of power and hand tools, trucks, and light machinery.
- Perform problem analysis, perform basic math, creatively solve work problems, and provide a high level of customer service.
- Speak, read, write, and understand English.
- Make decisions based on sound judgment leading to logical conclusions.
