

## **RESOLUTION NO. 24-0123-G9**

## A RESOLUTION AWARDING BIDS AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER AND/OR THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC WORKS TO PURCHASE MISCELLANEOUS STREET DEPARTMENT SUPPLEMENTAL MATERIALS FROM RECOMMENDED BIDDERS DURING FISCAL YEAR 2024.

**WHEREAS,** the City Commission wishes to maintain their streets, alleys, and right of ways in a manner consistent with standard and appropriate engineering practices; and

**WHEREAS,** the City of Ennis requested sealed bids for miscellaneous Street Department Supplemental Materials; and

**WHEREAS**, bids for these materials were opened and read aloud on November 20, 2023 at 2:30 p.m. and five (5) bidders submitted bids for one or more items contained in the Miscellaneous Street Department supplemental materials request for bid proposal; and

**WHEREAS**, the majority of funding for these materials will be provided by the FY24 Street Reconstruction budget and/or FY24 Operating Funds.

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF ENNIS, TEXAS, AS FOLLOWS:

**SECTION 1.** That the foregoing recitals are hereby found to be true and correct legislative findings of the City of Ennis, Texas, and are fully incorporated into the body of this Resolution.

**SECTION 2.** That bids are awarded for Street Materials to bidders in accordance with the Specifications for Miscellaneous Street Department Materials and as recommended and shown in the bid tabulation sheet and these bids are the lowest and/or best value to the City.

**SECTION 3.** Authorizes the City Manager and/or the Director of Public Works to purchase miscellaneous street department supplemental materials from approved bidders during FY24.

**SECTION 4.** It is hereby declared to be the intention of the City Commission that the phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs and sections of this Resolution are severable, and if any phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section of this Resolution shall be declared unconstitutional by the valid judgment or decree of any court of competent jurisdiction, such unconstitutionality shall not affect any of the remaining phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs and sections of this Resolution, since the same would have been enacted by the City Commission without the incorporation of this Resolution of any such unconstitutional phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section.

**SECTION 5.** That this Resolution shall become effective from and after its passage.
